Task Steps:	Potential Hazards	Steps To Prevent Hazards/Injury/Incident
Mobilize for task	Stuck equipment, uneven terrain/ mud/ Slippery surfaces	360 Walk Around / Assess the scenario, proper footing, use dry fill if necessary, get weights of vehicle/equipment to be recovered and capacity of recovery vehicle/equipment. Refer to equipment manual for attachment points for recovery. Select and inspect recovery equipment (rigging, shackles, etc). CHAINS ARE NOT ALLOWED!
Position recovery vehicle and attach recovery equipment/rigging	Struck by, caught in or between, line of fire	Keep personnel clear before positioning equipment. Turn equipment off and apply parking brake if equipped when hooking and unhooking recovery equipment / stay out of the 'line of fire" between and around vehicles and equipment. Cut level A5 or better gloves.
Start recovery operation	Caught in or between, breaking straps, struck by	Keep personnel clear of area before starting recovery. inspect recovery equipment prior to use to ensure correct capacities and inspect for damage.

Unhook recovery equipment	Pinch points, hand injuries	Cut level A5 or better gloves, watch hand placement
